Telemedicine & Electronic Health Records Physician Opportunities & Exposures

Government mandates and practical realities are placing new pressures on physicians and other health care providers to use telemedicine and electronic health records strategically. While recent Federal guidance provides new opportunities for physicians and other health care providers to work together to develop telemedicine and electronic health records strategies, many legal and operational traps remain.
