High profile mergers, acquisitions, joint ventures and other combinations among prominent health care systems, health insurers, and other health industry institutions continue to prompt scrutiny and concern about the potential anticompetitive effects of the resulting consolidation of market share and power of among a constricting group of market competitors. In the face of these developments, the Department of Justice Antitrust Division has undertaken litigation challenging various transactions and conduct it views as threatening marketplace competitiveness while continuing its ongoing scrutiny of other transactions and conduct for potentially harmful anticompetitive effects.
